EXECUTIVE ORDER # 152

Relating to a Proclamation that the Flag of the United States and the Flag of the State of Wisconsin be Flown at Half-Staff as a Mark of Respect for Specialist Eric Clark of the United States Army Who Lost His Life During Operation Iraqi Freedom

WHEREAS, on May 11, 2006, Specialist Eric Clark, a member of 3rd Battalion, 6th Field Artillery Regiment, 10th Mountain Division, United States Army, was killed in action in Iraq; and

WHEREAS, Specialist Eric Clark provided faithful and honorable service to the people of the State of Wisconsin and the people of the United States; and


WHEREAS, the people of Wisconsin mourn the death of Specialist Eric Clark; and

WHEREAS, Specialist Eric Clark will be laid to rest on Saturday, May, 20, 2006;


NOW, THEREFORE, I, JIM DOYLE, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, by the authority vested in me by Federal and State law, do hereby order that the flag of the United States and the flag of the State of Wisconsin shall be flown at half-staff at all buildings, grounds and military installations of the State of Wisconsin equipped with such flags beginning at sunrise on **May 20, 2006**, and ending at sunset on that date.
