EXECUTIVE ORDER # 153

Relating to a Proclamation that the Flag of the United States and the Flag of the State of Wisconsin be Flown at Half-Staff as a Mark of Respect for Specialist Grant Dampier of the United States Army Who Lost His Life During Operation Iraqi Freedom


WHEREAS, on May 15, 2006, Specialist Grant Dampier, a member of 1st Battalion, 8th Infantry Regiment, 3rd Heavy Brigade Combat Team, United States Army, was killed in action in Iraq; and

WHEREAS, Specialist Grant Dampier provided faithful and honorable service to the people of the State of Wisconsin and the people of the United States; and

WHEREAS, the people of Wisconsin mourn the death of Specialist Grant Dampier; and

WHEREAS, a funeral service will be held for Specialist Grant Dampier on Friday, May 26, 2006;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, JIM DOYLE, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, by the authority vested in me by Federal and State law, do hereby order that the flag of the United States and the flag of the State of Wisconsin shall be flown at half-staff at all buildings, grounds and military installations of the State of Wisconsin equipped with such flags beginning at sunrise on **May 26, 2006**, and ending at sunset on that date.


