Relating to a Proclamation that the Flag of the United States and the Flag of the State of Wisconsin be Flown at Half-Staff as a Mark of Respect for Hospitalman 2nd Class Jaime Jaenke of the United States Navy Reserve Who Lost Her Life During Operation Iraqi Freedom


WHEREAS, on June 5, 2006, Hospitalman 2nd Class Jaime Jaenke, a member of Naval Mobile Construction Battalion 25, United States Navy Reserve, died as a result of enemy action in Iraq; and

WHEREAS, Hospitalman 2nd Class Jaime Jaenke provided faithful and honorable service to the people of the State of Wisconsin and the people of the United States; and

WHEREAS, the people of Wisconsin mourn the death of Hospitalman 2nd Class Jaime Jaenke; and

WHEREAS, Hospitalman 2nd Class Jaime Jaenke will be laid to rest on Wednesday, June 14, 2006;


NOW, THEREFORE, I, JIM DOYLE, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, by the authority vested in me by Federal and State law, do hereby order that the flag of the United States and the flag of the State of Wisconsin shall be flown at half-staff at all buildings, grounds and military installations of the State of Wisconsin equipped with such flags beginning at sunrise on **June 14, 2006**, and ending at sunset on that date.
