EXECUTIVE ORDER # 164

Relating to a Proclamation that the Flag of the United States and the Flag of the State of Wisconsin be Flown at Half-Staff as a Mark of Respect for Corporal Stephen Castner of the Wisconsin Army National Guard Who Lost His Life During Operation Iraqi Freedom


WHEREAS, on July 24, 2006, Corporal Stephen Castner, a member of 1st Battalion, 121st Field Artillery, Wisconsin Army National Guard, died as a result of injuries sustained during enemy action in Iraq; and

WHEREAS, Corporal Stephen Castner provided faithful and honorable service to the people of the State of Wisconsin and the people of the United States; and


WHEREAS, the people of Wisconsin mourn the death of Corporal Stephen Castner; and

WHEREAS, a funeral service will be held for Corporal Stephen Castner on Friday, August 4, 2006 and a memorial service on Saturday, August 5, 2006;


NOW, THEREFORE, I, JIM DOYLE, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, by the authority vested in me by Federal and State law, do hereby order that the flag of the United States and the flag of the State of Wisconsin shall be flown at half-staff at all buildings, grounds and military installations of the State of Wisconsin equipped with such flags beginning at sunrise on August 4, 2006, and ending on sunset on August 5, 2006.
