Relating to a Proclamation that the Flag of the United States and the Flag of the State of Wisconsin be Flown at Half-Staff as a Mark of Respect for Senior Airman Adam Servais of the United States Air Force Who Lost His Life During Operation Enduring Freedom


WHEREAS, on August 19, 2006, Senior Airman Adam Servais, a member of the 23rd Special Tactics Squadron, United States Air Force, died as a result of injuries sustained during enemy action in Afghanistan; and

WHEREAS, Senior Airman Adam Servais provided faithful and honorable service to the people of the State of Wisconsin and the people of the United States; and


WHEREAS, the people of Wisconsin mourn the death of Senior Airman Adam Servais; and

WHEREAS, Senior Airman Adam Servais will be laid to rest on Saturday, August 26, 2006;


NOW, THEREFORE, I, JIM DOYLE, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, by the authority vested in me by Federal and State law, do hereby order that the flag of the United States and the flag of the State of Wisconsin shall be flown at half-staff at all buildings, grounds and military installations of the State of Wisconsin equipped with such flags beginning at sunrise on August 26, 2006, and ending at sunset on that date.
