EXECUTIVE ORDER # 168

Relating to a Proclamation that the Flag of the United States  
and the Flag of the State of Wisconsin be Flown at Half-Staff  
as a Mark of Respect for Corporal Kenneth Cross  
of the United States Army Who Lost His Life  
During Operation Iraqi Freedom

WHEREAS, on August 27, 2006, Corporal Kenneth Cross, a member of  
1st Battalion, 23rd Regiment, 3rd Brigade, 2nd Infantry Division, United States  
Army, died as a result of injuries sustained during enemy action in Iraq; and

WHEREAS, Corporal Kenneth Cross provided faithful and honorable  
service to the people of the State of Wisconsin and the people of the United  
States; and

WHEREAS, the people of Wisconsin mourn the death of Corporal  
Kenneth Cross; and


WHEREAS, Corporal Kenneth Cross will be laid to rest on Saturday,  
September 9, 2006;


NOW, THEREFORE, I, JIM DOYLE, Governor of the State of Wisconsin,  
by the authority vested in me by Federal and State law, do hereby order that  
the flag of the United States and the flag of the State of Wisconsin shall be  
flown at half-staff at all buildings, grounds and military installations of the  
State of Wisconsin equipped with such flags beginning at sunrise on  
September 9, 2006, and ending at sunset on that date.
