EXECUTIVE ORDER # 169

Relating to a Proclamation that the Flag of the United States and the Flag of the State of Wisconsin be Flown at Half-Staff as a Mark of Respect for Specialist Shaun Novak of the United States Army Who Lost His Life During Operation Iraqi Freedom

WHEREAS, on August 27, 2006, Specialist Shaun Novak, a member of 1st Battalion, 66th Armor Regiment, 1st Brigade, 4th Infantry Division, United States Army, died as a result of injuries sustained during enemy action in Iraq; and


WHEREAS, Specialist Shaun Novak provided faithful and honorable service to the people of the State of Wisconsin and the people of the United States; and

WHEREAS, the people of Wisconsin mourn the death of Specialist Shaun Novak; and


WHEREAS, Specialist Shaun Novak will be laid to rest on Saturday, September 9, 2006;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, JIM DOYLE, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, by the authority vested in me by Federal and State law, do hereby order that the flag of the United States and the flag of the State of Wisconsin shall be flown at half-staff at all buildings, grounds and military installations of the State of Wisconsin equipped with such flags beginning at sunrise on September 9, 2006, and ending at sunset on that date.
