EXECUTIVE ORDER # 176

Relating to a Proclamation that the Flag of the United States and the Flag of the State of Wisconsin be Flown at Half-Staff as a Mark of Respect for Lance Corporal Jesse Tillery of the United States Marines Who Lost His Life During Operation Iraqi Freedom

WHEREAS, on December 2, 2006, Lance Corporal Jesse Tillery, a member of 2nd Assault Amphibian Battalion, 2nd Marine Division, II Marine Expeditionary Force, United States Marines, died as a result of injuries sustained during enemy action in Iraq; and


WHEREAS, Lance Corporal Jesse Tillery provided faithful and honorable service to the people of the State of Wisconsin and the people of the United States; and


WHEREAS, the people of Wisconsin mourn the death of Lance Corporal Jesse Tillery; and

WHEREAS, a memorial service will be held for Lance Corporal Jesse Tillery Saturday, December 9, 2006;


NOW, THEREFORE, I, JIM DOYLE, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, by the authority vested in me by Federal and State law, do hereby order that the flag of the United States and the flag of the State of Wisconsin shall be flown at half-staff at all buildings, grounds and military installations of the State of Wisconsin equipped with such flags beginning at sunrise on **December 9, 2006**, and ending at sunset on that date.
