EXECUTIVE ORDER # 206

Relating to a Proclamation that the Flag of the United States and the Flag of the State of Wisconsin be Flown at Half-Staff as a Mark of Respect for Firefighter David Rufer of the Monroe Fire Department

WHEREAS, on June 12, 2007, Firefighter David Rufer died in the line of duty during a department training exercise; and


WHEREAS, Firefighter David Rufer served the people of Monroe and the people of Wisconsin with distinction and honor; and

WHEREAS, the people of Wisconsin mourn the death of Firefighter David Rufer; and


WHEREAS, Firefighter David Rufer will be laid to rest on Saturday, June 16, 2007; and

NOW, THEREFORE, I, JIM DOYLE, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, by the authority vested in me by Federal and State law, do hereby order that the flag of the United States and the flag of the State of Wisconsin shall be flown at half-staff at all buildings, grounds and military installations of the State of Wisconsin equipped with such flags beginning at sunrise on **Saturday, June 16, 2007**, and ending at sundown on that date.
