
WHEREAS, on September 5, 2007, Corporal Keith Nurnberg, a member of the 2nd Battalion, 69th Armor Regiment, 3rd Brigade Combat Team, 3rd Infantry Division, died as a result of injuries sustained during combat action in Iraq; and

WHEREAS, Corporal Keith Nurnberg provided faithful and honorable service to the people of the State of Wisconsin and the people of the United States; and

WHEREAS, the people of Wisconsin mourn the death of Corporal Keith Nurnberg; and


WHEREAS, Corporal Keith Nurnberg will be laid to rest on Saturday, September 15, 2007;


