EXECUTIVE ORDER # 220

Relating to a Proclamation that the Flag of the United States and the Flag of the State of Wisconsin be Flown at Half-Staff as a Mark of Respect for Corporal Rachael Hugo of the United States Army Who Lost Her Life During Operation Iraqi Freedom

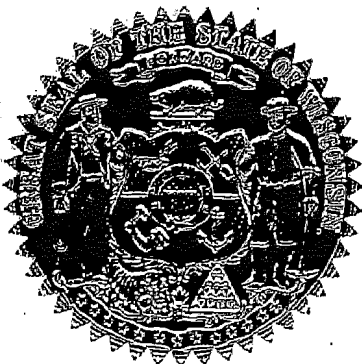
WHEREAS, on October 5, 2007, Corporal Rachael Hugo, a member of the 303rd Military Police Company, 97th Military Police Battalion, 89th Military Police Brigade, United States Army Reserve, died as a result of injuries sustained during combat action in Iraq; and

WHEREAS, Corporal Rachael Hugo provided faithful and honorable service to the people of the State of Wisconsin and the people of the United States; and

WHEREAS, the people of Wisconsin mourn the death of Corporal Rachael Hugo; and


WHEREAS, Corporal Rachael Hugo will be laid to rest on Wednesday, October 17, 2007;


NOW, THEREFORE, I, JIM DOYLE, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, by the authority vested in me by Federal and State law, do hereby order that the flag of the United States and the flag of the State of Wisconsin shall be flown at half-staff at all buildings, grounds and military installations of the State of Wisconsin equipped with such flags beginning at sunrise on October 17, 2007, and ending at sunset on that date.
