EXECUTIVE ORDER # 234

Relating to a Proclamation that the Flag of the United States and the Flag of the State of Wisconsin be Flown at Half-Staff as a Mark of Respect for Corporal Jason Lemke of the United States Army Who Lost His Life While Serving His Country


WHEREAS, on January 5, 2008, Corporal Jason Lemke, a member of the 2nd Battalion, 23rd Infantry Regiment, 4th Stryker Brigade Combat Team, 2nd Infantry Division, United States Army, died as a result of injuries sustained during enemy action in Iraq; and

WHEREAS, Corporal Jason Lemke provided faithful and honorable service to the people of the State of Wisconsin and the people of the United States; and

WHEREAS, the people of Wisconsin mourn the death of Corporal Jason Lemke; and

WHEREAS, Corporal Jason Lemke will be laid to rest on Wednesday, January 16, 2008;


NOW, THEREFORE, I, JIM DOYLE, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, by the authority vested in me by Federal and State law, do hereby order that the flag of the United States and the flag of the State of Wisconsin shall be flown at half-staff at all buildings, grounds and military installations of the State of Wisconsin equipped with such flags beginning at sunrise on January 16, 2008, and ending at sunset on that date.
