**Relating to a Proclamation that the Flag of the United States and the Flag of the State of Wisconsin be Flown at Half-Staff as a Mark of Respect for Mark Coyne, R.N., a member of the UW Hospital and Clinics Med Flight Crew**


**WHEREAS**, Mark Coyne, R.N., died after transferring a patient via a UW Hospital and Clinics Med Flight helicopter on May 10, 2008; and

**WHEREAS**, Mark Coyne, R.N., served the people of Wisconsin with distinction and honor; and

**WHEREAS**, the people of Wisconsin mourn the death of Mark Coyne, R.N.; and

**WHEREAS**, a memorial service will be held for Mark Coyne, R.N., on Monday, May 19, 2008; and


**NOW, THEREFORE, I, JIM DOYLE**, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, by the authority vested in me by Federal and State law, do hereby order that the flag of the United States and the flag of the State of Wisconsin shall be flown at half-staff at all buildings, grounds and military installations of the State of Wisconsin equipped with such flags beginning at sunrise on May 19, 2008, and ending at sunset on that date.
