EXECUTIVE ORDER # 263

Relating to a Proclamation that the Flag of the United States and the Flag of the State of Wisconsin be Flown at Half-Staff as a Mark of Respect for Fire Chief Frank Wichlacz of the Pulaski Tri-County Fire Department

WHEREAS, on July 23, 2008, Fire Chief Frank Wichlacz died in the line of duty; and

WHEREAS, Fire Chief Frank Wichlacz served the Pulaski Tri-County Fire Department for over fifty years with distinction and honor; and

WHEREAS, the people of Wisconsin mourn the death of Fire Chief Frank Wichlacz; and


WHEREAS, Fire Chief Frank Wichlacz will be laid to rest on Monday, July 28, 2008;


