**EXECUTIVE ORDER # 332**

**Relating to a Proclamation that the Flag of the United States and the Flag of the State of Wisconsin be Flown at Half-Staff as a Mark of Respect for Senior Airman Daniel Johnson of the United States Air Force Who Lost His Life While Serving His Country in Operation Enduring Freedom**

**WHEREAS**, on October 5, 2010, Senior Airman Daniel Johnson, who was assigned to 30th Civil Engineer Squadron, Vandenberg Air Force Base, CA, died while serving his country in Afghanistan; and

**WHEREAS**, Senior Airman Daniel Johnson provided faithful and honorable service to the people of the State of Wisconsin and the people of the United States; and


**WHEREAS**, the people of Wisconsin mourn the death of Senior Airman Daniel Johnson; and

**WHEREAS**, a memorial service will be held for Senior Airman Daniel Johnson on Monday, October 18, 2010;


**NOW, THEREFORE, I, JIM DOYLE**, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, by the authority vested in me by Federal and State law, do hereby order that the flag of the United States and the flag of the State of Wisconsin shall be flown at half-staff at all buildings, grounds and military installations of the State of Wisconsin equipped with such flags beginning at sunrise on **Monday, October 18, 2010**, and ending at sundown on that date.
