
**EXECUTIVE ORDER # 13**

**Relating to the Closure of State Government Offices to the Public  
and Amending Executive Order #12**


**WHEREAS**, on February 1, 2011, I, Scott Walker, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, by Executive Order #12, directed a closure of state government offices to the public in the designated area on February 2, 2011;

**NOW THEREFORE, I, Scott Walker**, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, pursuant to the authority vested in me by the Constitution and laws of this State and by Section 230.35(5)(c) of the Wisconsin Statutes, do hereby amend Executive Order #12 as follows:

1. The Capitol Building will remain open to the public in order for the Legislature and Supreme Court to conduct its business; and
2. Direct all necessary state agencies to support the Capitol remaining open to the public.
