



EXECUTIVE ORDER # 3

Relating to a Proclamation that the Flag of the United States and the Flag of the State of Wisconsin be Flown at Half-Staff as a Mark of Respect for Victims of the Tragedy in Tucson, Arizona


WHEREAS, on January 8, 2011, members of the Tucson, Arizona community tragically lost their lives due to senseless acts of violence; and

WHEREAS, the President has directed that the flag of the United States be flown at half-staff at all public buildings and grounds beginning January 9, 2011 and ending at sundown, Friday, January 14, 2011; and


WHEREAS, the people of the State of Wisconsin mourn the loss of all who died as a result of this tragedy; and

WHEREAS, the people of the State of Wisconsin wish to join communities across the country who are also mourning this tragedy; and

NOW, THEREFORE, I, SCOTT WALKER, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, by the authority vested in me by Federal and State law, do hereby order that the flag of the United States and the flag of the State of Wisconsin be flown half-staff at all buildings, grounds, and military installations of the State of Wisconsin equipped with such flags beginning **January 10, 2011** and ending at sundown on **January 14, 2011**.
