EXECUTIVE ORDER # 53

Relating to an Authorization for the Flag of the United States and the Flag of the State of Wisconsin to be Flown at Half-Staff as a Mark of Respect for Mayor Dick Bolender

WHEREAS, on December 10, 2011, Oak Creek Mayor Richard “Dick” Bolender died suddenly of natural causes; and

WHEREAS, Dick Bolender faithfully served the City of Oak Creek as Mayor since 2003; and


WHEREAS, a memorial service will be held for Mayor Bolender on December 14, 2011; and

WHEREAS, the City of Oak Creek petitioned the Office of the Governor, through their City Administrator, to approve the lowering of the flags;


