



EXECUTIVE ORDER # 62

Relating to a Proclamation that the Flag of the United States and the Flag of the State of Wisconsin be Flown at Half-Staff as a Mark of Respect for Firefighter Jamison Kampmeyer of the Colby Fire Department

WHEREAS, on March 4, 2012, Firefighter Jamison Kampmeyer tragically lost his life battling a fire in Abbotsford, Wisconsin; and

WHEREAS, Firefighter Jamison Kampmeyer was also a deputy sheriff with the Marathon County Sheriff's Department, serving the county for nearly eight years; and

WHEREAS, Firefighter Jamison Kampmeyer provided faithful and honorable service to his community and to the people of the State of Wisconsin; and


WHEREAS, the people of Wisconsin mourn the death of Firefighter Jamison Kampmeyer; and

WHEREAS, a memorial service will be held for Firefighter Jamison Kampmeyer on March 9, 2012;


NOW THEREFORE, I, SCOTT WALKER, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, by the authority vested in me by federal and state law, do hereby order that the flag of the United States and the flag of the State of Wisconsin shall be flown at half-staff at all buildings, grounds, and military installations of the State of Wisconsin equipped with such flags beginning at sunrise on **Friday, March 9, 2012**, and ending at sunset on that date.
