EXECUTIVE ORDER #71

Relating to a Proclamation that the Flag of the United States and the Flag of the State of Wisconsin be Flown at Half-Staff in the City of Fennimore as a Mark of Respect for Gary A. Banker, Long-Time Principal and Fennimore Citizen

WHEREAS, on May 22, 2012, former Fennimore High School Principal Gary A. Banker passed away; and

WHEREAS, Gary A. Banker honorably served and positively influenced young people in the Fennimore Community School District and the City of Fennimore as high school principal from 1968 until 1992; and

WHEREAS, Gary A. Banker continued to support youth after retirement and continued to be respected for his dedication and commitment to the students at Fennimore High School and the City of Fennimore; and


WHEREAS, a memorial service will be held for Gary A. Banker on Wednesday, May 30, 2012; and

WHEREAS, the City of Fennimore petitioned the Office of the Governor to approve the lowering of the flags;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, SCOTT WALKER, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, by the authority vested in me by federal and state law, do hereby authorize that the flag of the United States and the flag of the State of Wisconsin may be flown at half-staff at all public buildings equipped with such flags in the City of Fennimore beginning at sunrise on **Wednesday, May 30, 2012** and ending at sunset on that date.


