



EXECUTIVE ORDER #78

Relating to the Termination of the Energy Emergency

WHEREAS, the health, welfare, and economic well-being of the citizens of Wisconsin depend on petroleum products (gasoline and diesel fuel); and

WHEREAS, a leak was detected on the refined products West Shore Pipeline between Milwaukee and Green Bay, Wisconsin on July 17, 2012; and


WHEREAS, the detected leak triggered a shutdown of a portion of the pipeline beginning July 20, 2012; and

WHEREAS, on July 20, 2012, I issued Executive Order #77, proclaiming an Energy Emergency; and


WHEREAS, the pipeline has since been repaired and, after successful testing, restarted; and

WHEREAS, Executive Order #77 is no longer needed to be in place for 10 days, but because of logistics involved in restarting the pipeline, Executive order #77 shall remain effective until July 26, 2012 to ensure all outlets have adequate supplies;

NOW THEREFORE, I, SCOTT WALKER, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, by the authority vested in me by the laws and Constitution of this state, do hereby terminate Executive Order #77 at 11:59 p.m. on Thursday July 26, 2012.
