



**EXECUTIVE ORDER #93**

**Relating to a Proclamation that the Flag of the United States and the Flag of the State of Wisconsin be Flown at Half-Staff as a Mark of Respect for Fire Chief Philip Mortensen of the Brooklyn Area Fire and EMS Protection District**

**WHEREAS**, on December 22, 2012, Fire Chief Philip Mortensen of the Brooklyn Fire Department died within twenty-four hours of responding to an alarm call; and

**WHEREAS**, Chief Mortensen was a member of the Brooklyn Area Fire and EMS Protection District for nearly forty-two years, leading the District as fire chief since 1974; and

**WHEREAS**, Chief Mortensen provided faithful and honorable service to the people of Brooklyn and the State of Wisconsin; and

**WHEREAS**, the people of Wisconsin mourn the death of Chief Mortensen; and

**WHEREAS**, a memorial service will be held for Fire Chief Philip Mortensen on December 29, 2012.

**NOW, THEREFORE, I, SCOTT WALKER**, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, by the authority vested in me by federal and state law, do hereby order that the flag of the United States and the flag of the State of Wisconsin shall be flown at half-staff at all buildings, grounds, and military installations of the State of Wisconsin equipped with such flags beginning at sunrise on **Saturday, December 29, 2012** and ending at sunset on that date.


