EXECUTIVE ORDER #105

Relating to a Proclamation that the Flag of the United States and the Flag of the State of Wisconsin be Flown at Half-Staff in Vilas County as a Mark of Respect for Vilas County Sheriff Frank Tomlanovich

WHEREAS, on June 19, 2013, Vilas County Sheriff Frank Tomlanovich passed away; and

WHEREAS, Sheriff Tomlanovich faithfully and honorably served Vilas County for 34 years; and

WHEREAS, Sheriff Tomlanovich devoted his life to the protection of the people of Vilas County as a member of the Vilas County Sheriff's Office since 1979, serving as a patrol Deputy, Detective Sergeant, and as Sheriff; and

WHEREAS, Sheriff Tomlanovich was elected Sheriff of Vilas County in 2010; and


WHEREAS, the people of Wisconsin mourn the death of Sheriff Tomlanovich; and

WHEREAS, a memorial service will be held for Sheriff Tomlanovich on Monday, June 24, 2013.


