EXECUTIVE ORDER #108

Relating to a Proclamation that the Flag of the United States and the Flag of the State of Wisconsin be Flown at Half-Staff as a Mark of Respect for Dr. Stanley Phillips III, UW Health Neonatal Physician Who Lost His Life During a Medical Transport

WHEREAS, Dr. Phillips lost his life while working as a neonatal physician on a medical transport en-route to pick up a neonatal intensive care unit patient when the ambulance he was riding in overturned; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Phillips served the people of Wisconsin with distinction and honor; and


WHEREAS, the people of Wisconsin mourn the death of Dr. Phillips; and

WHEREAS, a memorial service will be held for Dr. Phillips on Friday, July 19, 2013.


