EXECUTIVE ORDER #109

Relating to a Proclamation that the Flag of the United States and the Flag of the State of Wisconsin be Flown at Half-Staff in the City of Mauston as a Mark of Respect for Sergeant Brian Faust, Mailroom Sergeant at Sand Ridge Secure Treatment Center and Long-Time State Employee

WHEREAS, on July 14, 2013, while en route to Sand Ridge Secure Treatment Center, employee Brian Faust was killed in a motorcycle accident; and

WHEREAS, Brian Faust honorably served the state of Wisconsin for over twenty years; and

WHEREAS, Brian Faust faithfully served at Sand Ridge Secure Treatment Center for eleven years; and


WHEREAS, a memorial service will be held for Brian Faust on July 20, 2013; and

WHEREAS, Sand Ridge Secure Treatment Center petitioned the Office of the Governor to approve the lowering of the flags.


