EXECUTIVE ORDER #268

Relating to a Proclamation that the Flag of the United States and the Flag of the State of Wisconsin Be Flown at Half-Staff as a Mark of Respect for Milwaukee Police Department Officer Kendall Corder

WHEREAS, on June 29, 2025, Milwaukee Police Department Officer Kendall Corder passed away at the age of 32 after sustaining life-threatening injuries in the line of duty;

WHEREAS, Officer Corder loved his work and was proud to be a member of the Milwaukee Police Department, where he served his community honorably for six years;

WHEREAS, on June 26, 2025, Officer Corder and his partner were both shot while responding to a call, and his lasting legacy will be the courage he demonstrated in upholding his honorable duty to defend public safety and protect the community he loved; and

WHEREAS, the people of Wisconsin join Officer Corder's family, friends, loved ones, colleagues, and the entire Milwaukee community in mourning his tragic passing.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, TONY EVERS, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, by the authority vested in me by the Constitution and the Laws of the State, hereby order that the flag of the United States and the flag of the State of Wisconsin shall be flown at half-staff at all buildings, grounds, and military installations of the State of Wisconsin, beginning immediately and ending at sunset on Tuesday, July 1, 2025, as well as on the date of interment.
