2003 Wisconsin Act 28 provides that cities, villages, or towns may seek reimbursement from a prisoner for the amount paid to a county for the expenses incurred by the county to incarcerate the prisoner. The city, village, or town may commence an action in circuit court to obtain a judgment for the expenses, and must do so within 12 months after the release of the prisoner or be barred from bringing the action.

Effective Date: The effective date of 2003 Wisconsin Act 28 is June 3, 2003.
