2003 Wisconsin Act 4 ratifies the collective bargaining agreement negotiated between the State of Wisconsin and the Wisconsin State Employees Union, for the 2001-03 Biennium, covering employees in the administrative support collective bargaining unit. The administrative support unit consists of roughly 7,019 full-time equivalent positions and includes clerical assistants, criminal history records specialists, employment security specialists, financial specialists, legal assistants, medical program assistants, payroll and benefit specialists, tax representatives and assistants, transportation customer representatives, and others.

**Effective Date:** The general effective date for Wisconsin Act 4 is May 17, 2003. However, the collective bargaining agreement ratified by Act 4 may contain other specific effective dates covering employees in the administrative support collective bargaining unit.
