2003 Wisconsin Act 112 ratifies the collective bargaining agreement negotiated between the State of Wisconsin and the Wisconsin Physicians and Dentists Association, for the 2003-05 Biennium, covering employees in the professional patient treatment collective bargaining unit. The professional patient treatment unit consists of approximately 103 employees (about 86 full-time equivalent positions) and includes doctors, dentists, psychiatrists, optometrists, and others.

Effective Date: The general effective date of 2003 Wisconsin Act 112 is January 24, 2004. However, the collective bargaining agreement ratified by Act 112 may contain other specific effective dates covering employees in the professional patient treatment collective bargaining unit.
