2003 Wisconsin Act 269 adds four University of Wisconsin (UW) System projects to the Authorized State Building Program and specifies the dollar amounts and sources of revenue for the projects. Those projects are as follows:

- UW-Madison--Ogg Residence Hall demolition and replacement; \$35,900,000.
- UW-Madison--School of Business graduate school facility; \$40,000,000 (which includes \$30,000,000 from gifts and grants).
- UW-Oshkosh--Taylor Hall renovation; \$13,000,000.
- UW-River Falls--Hunt Arena and Knowles Physical Education and Recreation Center addition and renovation; \$2,206,000.

The Act also specifies that statutory bidding requirements may not be waived for the above projects.

In addition, the Act states that rules of the Department of Commerce that require certain residence halls and dormitories to have automatic fire sprinkler systems do not apply to Ogg Residence Hall at UW-Madison until January 1, 2008.

Effective Date: The Act takes effect on May 1, 2004.
