

WISCONSIN LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL ACT MEMO

2007 Wisconsin Act 132 [2007 Assembly Bill 875]

Certification of Major Party Nominees

Generally, the state or national chairperson of each political party must certify the names of the party's nominees for President and Vice President to the Government Accountability Board no later than 5:00 p.m. on the first Tuesday in September preceding a presidential election.

Wisconsin Act 132 provides that, notwithstanding the general statutory provision, the Government Accountability Board must accept the certification of a party's nominees for the Offices of President and Vice President in 2008 if the certification is made no later than 5:00 p.m. on September 5, 2008.
