

WISCONSIN LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL ACT MEMO

2007 Wisconsin Act 137 [2007 Assembly Bill 594]

Remedial Legislation [Department of Transportation]

This legislation was suggested as remedial legislation by the Department of Transportation (DOT) and introduced by the Joint Legislative Council's Law Revision Committee under s. 13.83 (1) (c) 4. and 5., Stats.

2007 Wisconsin Act 137 clarifies, by the insertion of appropriate commas, that motor vehicles, recreational vehicles, trailers, semi-trailers, and other vehicles that must be registered with DOT must be currently registered or have a registration application in process to be operated on a highway.
