

WISCONSIN LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL ACT MEMO

2007 Wisconsin Act 181 [2007 Assembly Bill 597]

Interfering With a GPS Signal Used to Track a Sex Offender

Currently, it is a Class I felony to intentionally tamper with a GPS tracking device that is used to track a sex offender, as required under current law, without the authorization of the Department of Corrections. 2007 Wisconsin Act 181 additionally prohibits blocking, diffusing, or preventing the clear transmission of a signal transmitted by such a GPS tracking device.

Effective Date: Act 181 takes effect on April 10, 2008.
