2007 Wisconsin Act 198 [2007 Assembly Bill 677]

Invasion of Privacy

2007 Wisconsin Act 198 provides that whoever enters an enclosed or unenclosed common area of a multiunit dwelling or condominium and looks into an individual's dwelling unit is guilty of a Class A misdemeanor if: (1) the actor looks into the unit with an intent to intrude upon an individual's privacy and for the purpose of sexual gratification or arousal; (2) the actor looks into an area of the unit in which an individual is present; (3) the individual has a reasonable expectation of privacy in that area; and (4) the individual does not consent to the actor looking into that area.
