

## WISCONSIN LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL ACT MEMO

## 2007 Wisconsin Act 75 [2007 Senate Bill 436]

## Reports and Records Regarding the Occurrence of Fires

Under prior law, the Department of Commerce (Commerce) was required to maintain records of all fires occurring in this state.

2007 Wisconsin Act 75 replaces this with a requirement that, within 60 days of any fire that involves a building, the fire department of the city, village, or town where the fire occurred must file a report with the U.S. Fire Administration, for placement in that agency's fire incident reporting system. The Act specifies information that a fire report must include. It provides that Commerce may review, correct, or update any such report.

Effective Date: 2007 Wisconsin Act 75 takes effect on March 27, 2008.
