

WISCONSIN LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL ACT MEMO

2007 Wisconsin Act 78 [2007 Senate Bill 341]

Salary of Deputy District Attorneys

Under prior law, a deputy district attorney could not receive a salary in excess of the maximum of any pay range to which assistant district attorney positions were assigned. This limitation did not include additional compensation for supervisory duties.

Wisconsin Act 78 amends the statutes to provide that the state will establish and adjust the salaries of deputy district attorneys in accordance with the state compensation plan. Thus, the salary of a deputy district attorney will not necessarily be limited to the pay range applicable to assistant district attorney positions.

Effective Date: The Act takes effect on March 27, 2008.
