

WISCONSIN LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL ACT MEMO

2007 Wisconsin Act 93 [2007 Senate Bill 368]

Remedial Legislation [Department of Transportation]

This legislation was suggested as remedial legislation by the Department of Transportation (DOT) and introduced by the Joint Legislative Council's Law Revision Committee under s. 13.83(1)(c) 4. and 5., Stats.

2007 Wisconsin Act 93 corrects an error in 2005 Wisconsin Act 363 by clarifying that the length exception allowing 28 feet 6 inch semi-trailers or trailers operated as part of a double bottom applies to highways designated by DOT.
