## 2009 Wisconsin Act 139 [2009 Assembly Bill 166]

## Pesticide Use by Veterinarians

2009 Wisconsin Act 139 eliminates the requirement that a veterinary clinic at which pesticides are repackaged or used have a veterinary clinic permit issued by the Department of Agriculture, Trade, and Consumer Protection. The Act also prohibits the Veterinary Examining Board from requiring training and continuing education concerning the use and disposal of pesticides.

Effective date: March 18, 2010.
