

WISCONSIN LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL ACT MEMO

2009 Wisconsin Act 239 [2009 Senate Bill 445]

Labeling of Certain Fire Hazards

Prior law prohibited any person from selling or distributing a package of a substance that, when mixed with organic matter, may cause spontaneous combustion unless the package bears a label warning of this hazard. 2009 Wisconsin Act 239, recommended as remedial legislation by the Department of Commerce, repeals this labeling requirement.

Effective date: 2009 Wisconsin Act 239 took effect on May 20, 2010.
