

WISCONSIN LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL ACT MEMO

2009 Wisconsin Act 249 [2009 Senate Bill 494]

Remedial Legislation [Department of Health Services]

This legislation was suggested as remedial legislation by the Department of Health Services and introduced by the Joint Legislative Council's Law Revision Committee under s. 13.83 (1) (c) 4. and 5., Stats.

2009 Wisconsin Act 249 allows aging units that are private, nonprofit corporations to apply to operate an aging and disability resource center. An aging and disability resource center is an organization that provides services to certain elderly and disabled individuals. Services include providing information and referral services related to long-term care and eligibility screening for the Family Care Program benefit.
