



WISCONSIN LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL ACT MEMO

2009 Wisconsin Act 34
[2009 Assembly Bill 95]

Preparation Time

Under current law, the Municipal Employment Relations Act requires that a municipal employer bargain collectively with respect to wages, hours, and conditions of employment.

2009 Wisconsin Act 34 provides that, in a school district, the municipal employer is also required to bargain collectively with respect to time spent during the school day, separate from pupil contact time, to prepare lessons, labs, or educational materials, to confer or collaborate with other staff, or to complete administrative duties.

Effective Date: The Act takes effect on August 4, 2009, and first applies to collective bargaining agreements that cover any period that begins after June 30, 2011.
