

WISCONSIN LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL ACT MEMO

2011 Wisconsin Act 106 [2011 Senate Bill 196]

Expenditure Restraint Program and Purchases on Behalf of Schools

Under the expenditure restraint program, a municipality qualifies for a payment if its property tax levy rate is greater than five mills and if its municipal budget increased by less than a specified rate. In calculating the figure for the municipal budget, certain expenditures are not included.

Act 106 provides that expenditures made pursuant to a purchasing agreement with a school district under which the municipality makes purchases on behalf of the school district are not included in determining the municipal budget for purposes of the expenditure restraint program.

Effective date: Act 106 took effect on December 21, 2011 and first applies to payments made in 2013.
