

WISCONSIN LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL ACT MEMO

2011 Wisconsin Act 152 [2011 Assembly Bill 383]

Disposal of Oil Absorbent Materials

Prior law prohibited the disposal of oil absorbent materials that contain waste oil in a solid waste disposal facility. However, this prohibition did not apply to the disposal of less than one gallon of oil absorbent materials that contained waste oil resulting from a nonroutine spill.

2011 Wisconsin Act 152 replaced these provisions and provides instead that a person may not dispose of oil absorbent materials that contain waste oil in a solid waste disposal facility unless all of the following apply: (1) the waste oil has been drained from the materials so that no visible signs of free flowing oil remain in or on the oil absorbent materials; and (2) the materials are not hazardous waste.

Effective date: Act 152 takes effect on April 7, 2012.
