2011 Wisconsin Act 248 [2011 Assembly Bill 152]

Airport Improvement Projects

Prior Law

Under prior state law, when an airport improvement project involved federal aid, the state could contribute up to 50% of the costs in excess of the federal government's share of the project. When an airport improvement project did not involve federal aid, the state could contribute up to 80% of the cost of the project. For both types of projects, prior law capped the amount the state could pay at \$500,000 and prohibited the state's contribution from being used for the cost of hangars.

2011 WISCONSIN ACT 248

2011 Wisconsin Act 248 raises the cap on the amount the state may contribute to an airport improvement project to \$1,250,000, both for projects that involve federal aid and those that do not. The Act does not change current law with respect to: (1) the percentage allocations the state may pay for airport improvement projects; or (2) the prohibition on using the state's contribution for hangars.

Effective date: April 20, 2012.
