2013 Wisconsin Act 178 [2013 Assembly Bill 419]

Counting Votes for Write-In Candidates

2013 Wisconsin Act 178 provided that write-in votes are only counted under the following circumstances: (1) if no candidates have been certified to appear on the election ballot; (2) for write-in candidates who file registration statements (if candidates have been certified to appear on the ballot); or (3) if a candidate certified to appear on the ballot dies or withdraws before the election.

Effective date: April 4, 2014.
