

WISCONSIN LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL ACT MEMO

2015 Wisconsin Act 92 [2015 Senate Bill 217]

School Board Members Serving as Volunteer Coaches or Extracurricular Activity Supervisors

Under the common law doctrine of incompatibility of offices, a person may not hold two or more public positions when the duties of each position might conflict or when one position is superior to the other.

2015 Wisconsin Act 92 creates a limited exception to the doctrine of incompatibility of offices for school board members. Under the Act, a school board member may hold a position as a volunteer coach or as an extracurricular activity supervisor if the following conditions are met: (1) the school board member is not compensated for serving as a coach or activity supervisor; (2) the school board member abstains from voting on any issue that substantially and directly relates to the activity coached or supervised; and (3) the school board member completes a criminal background check. Under the Act, a school board member who serves as a volunteer coach or extracurricular activity supervisor may vote on the school district's annual budget.
