2019 Wisconsin Act 49 [2019 Senate Bill 74]

Interstate Medical License Compact

2015 Wisconsin Act 116 ratified and entered Wisconsin into the Interstate Medical Licensure Compact, which provides a process that allows certain physicians to become licensed in multiple states. The compact provides that a state may withdraw from the compact by repealing the statute authorizing the compact. 2015 Act 116 provided for the repeal of the statutes authorizing the compact on December 16, 2019, which, under the compact, would consequently result in Wisconsin's withdrawal from the compact.

2019 Wisconsin Act 49 repeals the provisions in 2015 Act 116 that provided for the repeal of the statutes authorizing the compact.
