Senate Bill 75 relates to the fees that may be charged by notary publics.

Under Senate Bill 75, a notary public is authorized to charge “a reasonable fee” for any service that he or she provides in his or her capacity as a notary public.

Senate Amendment __ provides that the notary public may charge a reasonable fee to *not to exceed \$5* for any service he or she provides in his or her capacity as a notary public.
