### Assembly Substitute Amendment 2

Assembly Substitute Amendment 2 would require the Department of Transportation to issue multiple trip permits to qualified applicants authorizing trucks transporting granular roofing material to exceed the generally applicable gross vehicle weight limit of 80,000 pounds by up to 10,000 pounds. Such a permit would not be valid on the national system of interstate and defense system highways except for up to 2.5 miles on state trunk highways.

Specific information would be required in the permit application including identification of the motor carrier and the originating location, destination, and route. Use of a road other than those within the state trunk highway system in a permitted route would have to be approved in writing by the local governing body with jurisdiction over the road. This multiple trip permit would sunset approximately three years after the effective date of the legislation.

### **Legislative History**

Assembly Substitute Amendment 2 was introduced by Representative Petrowski. The Assembly Committee on Transportation recommended adoption of Assembly Substitute Amendment 2 and passage of Assembly Bill 755, as amended, by votes of Ayes, 12; Noes, 0.
