2007 Assembly Bill 757 makes various changes to unemployment insurance (UI) law, including benefit rate and UI tax changes.

Assembly Amendment 1 repeals the 2010 sunset of the absenteeism or tardiness provision under current UI law that provides that an employee who is discharged for failing to notify his or her employer of absenteeism or tardiness may be ineligible to receive UI benefits for a specified period of time.

Legislative History

Assembly Amendment 1 was offered by Representative Honadel. On February 20, 2008, the Assembly Committee on Labor and Industry recommended adoption of the amendment on a vote of Ayes, 9; Noes, 0, and passage of the bill, as amended, on a vote of Ayes, 8; Noes, 1.
